

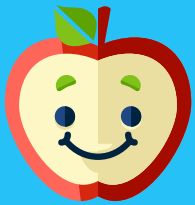
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Parent Tips For Shared Reading



Ask Questions- When? Where? Who? What happened? How did the story end?

Comment on Facial Expressions- to help children recognize feelings and understand other perspectives.

Use Your Voice- Use inflection in your voice when reading to demonstrate feelings and develop comprehension strategies.

Retelling- Use props to help children to retell a story.

Critical Thinking and Predictive Questions- What do you think...? I wonder...? What do you think happens next?

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
